## OFSC 2018-2019 CARNIVAL RULES

As passed by the OFSC Board of Directors on September 10, 2018.

- 1. Carnival solos will be drawn out of a hat and will be spotlighted in a group number.
- Names will be drawn out of a hat for all sessions, for 3 spotlight solos. (1 per session for each of Bronze, Silver and Gold session Only home club Orillia skaters may put their name in the hat. -solo length - 1:40max
- 3. Any skater who has been a member of the OFSC for 12 years or more and has never had a feature or spotlight, will automatically receive a spotlight in the Carnival for their session.
- 4. Any skater who competes at Sectionals (through the qualifying process) will be featured in the Carnival if they meet the following criteria:
  - a) Must be registered in the Orillia FSC competitive session
  - b) One feature solo <u>only</u> will be awarded for each Sectional category (ie PreNovice Women, Novice Women, Junior Women, Senior Women + Men.) The soloist will be picked on the basis of their highest <u>total</u> scores from the Sectionals Championship.

-Solo length – PreNovice/Novice - 2:40 max Junior/Senior - 3:00max

5. Any skaters who qualify at a provincial level in Special Olympics will be featured in the

Carnival.

-solo length – 1:40max

6. Any skater who receives a feature regardless of the discipline (freeskate, dance or pairs) will

not be eligible to put their name in the hat for a spotlight.

- 7. Home club (Orillia) skaters will not be paid if they are featured in the Carnival. This is subject to Skate Canada guidelines.
- 8. All skating members with a full or part time membership will participate in the groups they qualify for, but they must meet the Carnival practice attendance requirements.

- 9. Carnival attendance is Mandatory for all skaters on Bronze, Silver, Gold, Program assistant, Dance Number and Competitive sessions. Skaters on these sessions may miss one practice/rehearsal for each number they are participating in. Any skater who is absent for 2 practices/rehearsals will NOT be allowed to skate in that number during the carnival performances.
- 10. Any skater who is 10min. late for a practice/rehearsal will be docked ½ of an absence.
- 11. Program Assistants will have a number in the Carnival.
- 12. Skaters skating on the Competitive session will have a number in the Carnival.
- 13. Skaters must have passed their complete Senior Silver Dances by December 31, 2018 to be in the Dance Number. The skaters that qualify for this MUST raise enough money to fund the dance number. A decision will be made by December 31<sup>st</sup> if enough funds have been raised.
- 14. Little Stars will have a number in the carnival
- 15. Each skater is entitled to one number for their session, plus any specialty numbers. Specialty numbers include Little Stars, Program Assistant, Competitive and Dance number.
