This competition will be held in accordance with the rules of the Skate Canada and special guidelines set up and approved by Skate Ontario.

Entry Fees:

\$20.00 per Competitive Solo Simulation

All registration and payment will be made through the Orillia FSC website, and only credit card payments will be accepted. Skaters MUST be registered with the OFSC spring school in order to register and be able to pay at Check Out.

Entry Deadline: Saturday March 9th at 11:59pm.

Refunds: Refunds will be issued ONLY if the event is not held.

Test and Age Requirements: Test qualifications and age requirements as of January 1, 2019.

Music: Will be played from the club I-pod from the music room. There is NO need to register music.

Commencement of Events: Competition will run from 8am to 8pm.

Officials: Panels will consist of 3 judges. A Technical Representative of the competition will assign judging panels.

Marking system: All skaters for all levels will be **assessed to standard** for ALL levels of freeskate, showcase, interpretive, dance and elements. All skaters will receive a report card indicating a Gold, Silver, Bronze or Merit placement.

Awards: Medals will be presented for all skaters achieving a Gold, Silver or Bronze placement. A ribbon will be awarded for a Merit placement.

Confirmation of Entry: Confirmation of acceptance and a schedule of events will be forwarded to each Coach.

Videotaping: Private videotaping of your own competitor **only** is permitted.

Admission: \$3.00 per person Children 5 yrs and Under - Free

ICE DREAMS EVENTS

FREESKATE CATEGORIES – Skaters are only permitted to enter one Freeskate category, with the exception of STAR 7 & STAR 9 short program, and competitive solo simulation.

Special Olympic skaters will be entered into their appropriate category.

-Skaters will be divided into flight by age if numbers warrant

Little Stars — These skaters will be learning a solo as a group. Skaters will have the opportunity to perform their solo one at a time.

STAR 1 Program - 1.5- 2min (+/-10)solo with the following elements:

- Waltz jump toe loop combo
- Salchow
- Toe loop
- Loop
- 1/2 flip
- 1 foot spin
- back upright spin
- Forward Spiral Sequence: A sequence of two forward spirals with no more than 8 steps in between; one spiral on each foot, unsupported position; on either inside or outside edge

-Forward Turn Sequence: Forward Outside Three turn + backward crosscut (4 times)

SHOWCASE CATEGORIES – Programs are intended to be entertaining and will be assessed on their theatrical and artistic qualities. Emphasis is placed on the interpretation of the music. Costumes are permitted and props should enhance the theme of the program.

Skaters will be divided into flight by age if numbers warrant Skaters are expected to enter the level they are currently freeskating at.

STAR 1 Showcase – for skaters competing at the STAR 1 Free skate level

STAR 2 Showcase – for skaters completing at the STAR 2 Free skate level

STAR 3 Showcase – for skaters competing at the STAR 3 Free skate level

STAR 4 Showcase – for skaters competing at the STAR 4 Free skate level

STAR 5 Showcase – for skaters competing in the STAR 5 Freeskate level or higher

SOLO DANCE - Skaters will perform only one dance. -Series 8 dance music will be played.

STAR 2 - Dutch Waltz (2 patterns) - may have passed STAR 2A or 2B but not both

STAR 3 - Baby Blues (2 patterns) - may have passed STAR 3A or 3B but not both

STAR 4 - Fiesta Tango (2 patterns) – may have passed STAR 4A or 4B but not both

STAR 5 - Willow Waltz (2 patterns)- may have passed STAR 5A or 5B but not both

STAR 6 - Fourteenstep (3 patterns) - must NOT have passed the complete Senior Bronze dances

STAR 7 - Keats Foxtrot (3 patterns) - must NOT have passed the complete Junior Silver dances

STAR 8 - Kilian (3 patterns) - must NOT have passed the complete Senior Silver dances

STAR 9 - Blues (3 patterns) - must NOT have passed the complete Senior Silver dances

STAR 10 - Quickstep (3 patterns)- must NOT have passed the complete Gold dances

Gold - Argentine (3 patterns) – MAY have completed the complete Gold dances

INDIVIDAUL ELEMENTS

- Skaters MUST enter the same level or higher as they entered in their freeskate Program.
- Each skater will perform 4 elements in isolation in the order listed for their level of competition.
- Each element may only be attempted once
- All skaters will perform element 1, before performing element 2, and so on.
- STAR 2 to STAR 6 events will use half-ice to perform their elements.
- STAR 7 to Gold events will use full ice.
- Spins will not be assigned levels and will be assessed on quality only.
