PreCanSkate & CanSkate NEWS

Welcome Back!!! We are so happy that the arena is open, and we can offer our Learn to Skate programs.

Considering recent updates from both the province and the city of Orillia, we have had to update our skating protocols to ensure we can run all our programs safely. Our sessions have been divided to ensure we follow the 50% capacity limits, but we assure you all our skaters will be able to learn and develop their skating skills.

Please follow the guidelines listed below:

DRESSING ROOMS

1. NO dressing Rooms for PreCan and CanSkate skaters (Advanced CanSkaters may use the dressing room assigned to them & masks must always be worn in the dressing room)
2. It is recommended that skaters come with their skates on. There are limited benches available in the lobby if needed. Parents must keep boots and jackets with them, they can't be left in the lobby.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS

1. **ONE** parent only will be allowed in for PreCan, CanSkate and Advanced CanSkate
2. Siblings will only be allowed in if they are also scheduled to skate on that same day

ENTERING & EXITING ICE SURFACE FOR PreCan & CanSkate

Rotary

1. Skaters will enter the ice surface at the far entrance to the ice (closest to the Zamboni door)
2. Skaters will exit the ice surface at the end closest to the lobby.
3. Parents are asked to move along and sit near the exit door.
4. Dressing Room # 2 will be used as a washroom for skaters.

Brian Orser

1. Skaters will enter the ice surface closest to the music room.
2. Skaters will exit the ice surface closest to the Zamboni door.
3. Parents are asked to exit the bleachers when the name tags are collected and head over to the Zamboni door area.
4. Referees room will be used as a washroom for skaters.

ENTERING & EXITING FACILITIES

Rotary

1. Parents and skaters MUST enter through the front doors of the arena.
2. Parents and skaters MUST exit through the side doors by the tennis courts.

1. Parents and skaters MUST enter through the front doors of the arena.
2. Parents and skaters MUST exit through the side door of the arena which is located at the end of the hallway past the dressing rooms.
