We would like to take this time to welcome everyone to our 2026/2027 fall/winter skating session. This session will run from Thursday, September 10, 2026 to Thursday, March 11, 2027.

Programs will run out Rotary Place on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays and Brian Orser Arena on Wednesdays.

Club Commitment Policy for 2026/2027

During the 2026 -2027 season, StarSkate families will be asked to participate in three club commitments.

- First, each StarSkate family will be responsible for **playing music** on their skater's session each month as scheduled. If the skater's family agrees to this club commitment, their **registration cost** will be **reduced by \$150**.
- Each StarSkater will also be required to sell two booklets for the "**Gas for a Year**" fundraiser. Each booklet contains 5 tickets; each ticket is \$20.00. If the skater's family agrees to this club commitment, their **registration cost** will be **reduced by \$200**.
- Finally, each skater will be required to work one 2 hour shift during our spring Tag Day. Date and times of shifts will be forthcoming. If the skater's family agrees to this club commitment, their **registration cost** will be **reduced by \$150**.

If the skater's family agrees to all three club commitments, their **registration cost** will be **reduced by \$500**.
