## FUNDRAISING UPDATE

Money raised during our 2022/23 Gas for a Year fundraiser has been used this season to offset costs of registration for all StarSkaters who participated. When registering in Uplifter, there will be a \$100.00 credit for each skater who sold tickets last year.

Furthermore, as the ice at Rotary Place will not be available until a week later this year, money raised will be used to pay for the open ice sessions provided at Brian Orser Arena for all StarSkaters Friday September 8th and Friday, September 15th.

## PROGRAM ASSISTANTS NEEDED
