

- ▶ All skaters, PLEASE show up for your regular skating times. The ice schedule WILL remain the same. Dressing rooms will be set up for each carnival number as shown in the charts. **You MUST wear ALL of your accessories that are needed for each costume, which is listed in your January carnival newsletter.**
- ▶ When you arrive at the arena, go to your assigned dressing room, put your costume on, and skate on your REGULAR session. Each group will be called off the ice to have their group and individual pictures taken. **Please be PATIENT! We have a lot of skaters to photograph in a short period of time. We will try our best to stay on time!** After the picture, skaters may go back on the ice if time permits for their session.

Photos WILL be taken at the scheduled times and in the scheduled order.  
We can NOT retake pictures for those who arrive late.

- ▶ At the end of your session, costumes are to be removed and left in the change room. **DO NOT** take any part of your costume home, except the accessories you provided. (unless you want to leave your accessories with your costume).

Photos will be taken by John Pratt Photography. Each skater can purchase a 8X10 photo that features an individual portrait and group photo at a cost of \$7.50+hst per skater. Order forms are provided by the photographer. If you do not wish to purchase photos, your child is still encouraged to be in the group photo. This group photo will be included in the carnival program. Carnival programs will be sold on carnival day for \$5.00 each.
