ORILLIA FIGURE SKATING CLUB – CARNIVAL NEWSLETTER



The Orillia Figure Skating Club is actively planning our Club Carnival "British Invasion". Our Carnival is scheduled for Saturday, March 2, 2019, with two shows at 2:00pm and 7:00pm at Rotary arena. The dress rehearsal will be on Friday March 1, 2019. Please read through this newsletter carefully for important information regarding the day of the show and Dress Rehearsal information.

DRESS REHEARSAL

Friday March 1st - ROTARY ARENA

Attached is a dress rehearsal schedule for everyone. Please arrive 45 minutes early. ALL skaters MUST be signed in at the sign in table. Please make sure for Dress Rehearsal and both shows to wear your required accessories to the arena under your street clothes. A list was provided before picture day as to what is required for each skaters. Costumes provided by the club are to stay in the dressing rooms at all times and are NOT to go home with any skaters. *ALL SKATERS MUST HAVE THE CORRECT ACCESSORIES WITH THEM AND MUST HAVE SKATE GUARDS!* ONLY PreCanSkate parents will be allowed in the dressing room. CanSkate and StarSkate parents will **not** be allowed in the dressing room area unless they are registered volunteers for the dress rehearsal. Please note: food and drinks are NOT allowed in the dressing rooms.

CARNIVAL PERFORMANCES Saturday March 2nd – ROTARY ARENA

Skaters must be signed in at the security desk 45 minutes before the carnival performances start. At 1:15pm and 6:15pm (if skating in the first half of the show), or before intermission at 2:00 and 7:00pm (if skating in the second half of the show). Please see order of the show included in this newsletter to determine what time your child should arrive. Parents will **not** be allowed in the dressing room area unless they are registered volunteers for that performance.

Please note: food and drinks are NOT allowed in the dressing rooms.

ATTENTION PRECANSKATE PARENTS

All PreCanSkate skaters are required to have one parent assist each skater in the dressing room. One parent and child must register at the sign in table 45 minutes before each carnival performance including Dress rehearsal. The parent will accompany his/her child to the dressing room, assist to put on costume and skates. **All skaters MUST HAVE SKATE GUARDS** — with last name clearly marked on the guards for Dress Rehearsal and both Performances. The parent will proceed to line up with their skater and accompany them to the back of the stage (ice curtain entrance). The parent volunteers will be able to watch their skater from the far end of the arena. Once the skaters are finished performing, the parents will escort their skater back to the change room to help them change and finally sign out from the security table. Parents and skaters will receive a wristband so they can then go enjoy the rest of the show.

ATTENTION CANSKATE PARENTS

All CanSkate skaters MUST register at the sign in table 45 minutes before dress rehearsal and each performance. ONLY parents who have signed up to volunteer in the dressing rooms will be allowed in the dressing room area. Once signed in, your child will be escorted to the appropriate dressing room. Volunteers will assist with costumes and skates.

Fifteen minutes after your child has finished skating in the show, parents MUST pick-up their skaters(s) in the designated "pick up" area (main lobby near the Orillia Room). Parents may NOT wait until intermission or the end of the show to pick up their skater(s). Parents will be required to sign in/out their skater(s) for Dress Rehearsal and both shows. Parent volunteers and Skaters will be provided with a wristband for access to the rest of the show.

ATTENTION STARSKATERS

All StarSkaters MUST register at the sign in table for dress rehearsal and both performances. Skaters are reminded that that NO bootover tights are allowed. ALL Bronze, Silver, Gold skaters, as well as soloists MUST stay for Finale practice on the night of Dress Rehearsal. *See schedule attached for details*.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

The production of the carnival would not be possible without the help of our parent volunteers. Volunteers will be needed for before the carnival (set up), after the carnival (take down), dress rehearsal and both the afternoon and evening shows.

TICKETS

Tickets can be purchased at the PreCan/CanSkate table from 5:00 – 7:00 on Mondays and Wednesdays (Mondays at Rotary Place and Wednesdays at Brian Orser) as well as EACH DAY on the week of February 25th including Dress Rehearsal. Tickets are \$10 per person. Skaters participating in the carnival will receive a wristband and have free access to the show.

Tickets can also be purchased at the door.

For those that did NOT order pictures- you will still have an opportunity to purchase through the link provided by the photographer. These pictures can be purchased online, and will be ready at carnival.

VIDEOS - JB Video will be videotaping both performances. Carnival videos can be purchased on the day of the show.

PARKING — Parking for dress rehearsal and both performances will be limited (especially if we continue to get more snow in the weeks ahead) Please arrange to carpool if possible. Parking will be available on the road between the pylon barriers on the day of the show.
