About our Learn to Skate Programs:

Pre-CanSkate: For children ages 3-5 as of Dec 31, 2025

This is a learn to skate program for new skaters featuring a low coach to skater ratio (1:10) as well as Program Assistants to help.

CSA hockey helmets MUST be worn by all skaters. NO bike or ski helmets permitted.

CanSkate: For skaters who completed the Pre-CanSkate program OR who are ages 6+

This learn to skate program incorporates fun with the basics of skating focusing on agility, control and balance. Skaters work through 6 stages of badges.

CSA hockey helmets MUST be worn by all skaters until they have completed their Stage 5 badge. NO bike or ski helmets permitted.

Advanced CanSkate:

This program is designed for skaters to have some extra ice time to enhance the skills and techniques they have learned during the CanSkate program. Skaters must be registered for a minimum one-day CanSkate membership.

This program is by **invite only**.

Development Team:

This program is designed to focus and improve on skater's edges, turns, crosscuts, field moves, spins and jumps. Skaters must be registered for a minimum one-day CanSkate membership.

This program is by **invite only**.

Adult Open Session:

This program is open to adult skaters looking to work on their skating skills. This is not a learn to skate program. Some skating experience is necessary. A 15-minute group lesson is included in the fee (for those who are interested). Private instruction is available upon request.

This program starts Thursday April 2, 2026.
