ROWAN'S LAW

As many of you may be aware, aspects of Rowan's Law (Concussion Safety), 2018 and Ontario Regulation 161/19 (the regulations that support Rowan's Law) came into effect on July 1, 2019. Additional aspects will come into effect on July 1, 2020.

Skate Ontario therefore requires that ALL skaters in ALL programs, parents (if the skater is under the age of 18 years), coaches, officials and other designated persons have confirmed they have reviewed the required Concussion Awareness Resources and Concussion Code of Conduct. This confirmation must be in writing and these acknowledgement forms must be retained on file by the club/school.

The necessary background material was sent by email for you & your skater to review; by hyperlinks to a variety of concussion resources can be found in the first document. Please take some time to review this material so that our skaters are concussion aware and safe. The second attachment contains Skate Ontario's Concussion Code of Conduct for Athletes and Parent/Guardians.

The confirmation form must to be returned to the Club no later than Monday, November 18th or, as per Skate Ontario regulations, your skater will not be allowed on the ice until it has been returned.
