Music Club Policy

- StarSkate parents must commit to a regular rotation of playing music during their child's registered session(s). It is the parents' responsibility to find a replacement or switch days with another parent if they cannot attend on the scheduled date. If you have not made arrangements to cover your music obligation then your child will be taken off the ice to play music for the session. If a parent continuously misses or fails to find a replacement for their session, it would be at the OFSC Board's discretion to charge the \$120.00 fee to their account.

Group Freeskate Lessons

We are including group freeskate lessons one day a week during the winter season for Bronze and Silver sessions. Skaters will have an opportunity to work with each of our coaches that are on the session. Skaters will be grouped according to skill level and rotate amongst our highly trained coaches. This is a great opportunity for skaters to not only work with their coach, but learn from other coaches as well. Skaters will be charged a fee for the semi-private lessons they will be receiving. However, this fee will be split by the number of skaters that are in the group which means skaters will, in some cases, be receiving more lessons for less cost. It is the parent's responsibility to pay each coach. If your child chooses to skate on the day group freeskate is taking place (Monday for Silver and Wednesday for Bronze), your child will be expected to participate in all the lessons and will be charged accordingly.

Cancellation Policy:

- Withdrawal from a skating session before the first day of skating:Skaters who wish to withdraw from skating for any non-medical or non-injury related reason may receive a refund provided they withdraw before the start of the first skating session. These cases will be charged a \$45.00 administrative fee.
- Withdrawal from a skating session once a skating session has started: Skaters who wish to withdraw from skating for any non-medical or non-injury related reason may receive a refund. These cases will be charged a \$75.00 administrative fee plus the non-refundable Skate Canada membership fee of \$45.00.

Dress Code:

- Proper attire must be worn on all sessions(Girls: tights, dressed, skirt or leggings. Boys: athletic non-baggy pants). NO SHORTS ALLOWED during on-ice sessions. Long hair should be tied back.

Sessions:

- Each of our sessions are broken down into three sections. **Skills, Freeskate, and Dance.** If your skater is not in a lesson, they are required to follow the section they are in. (Skaters are not permitted to do freeskate for the entire session unless in a lesson the entire time.)
